

Dr. Dean Luethi is an Associate Professor and Director of the School of Music at Washington State University in Pullman. In addition to his administrative duties Dean also teaches applied music theory. At WSU Dr. Luethi serves on the Academic Affairs Committee, UCORE (general education requirements) Course Review Committee, and is a board member of the WSU Center for Arts and Humanities. He has guest performed or presented research in China, India, Cuba, New Foundland, Hawaii, Austria, and Poland. He is sought after as a guest conductor, adjudicator, and clinician, has been published in several journals and is the author of a book of pedagogical exercises for choirs published by GIA. He is currently working on a virtual choral conducting series for the National Association for Music Educators' Council for Choral Education to be distributed to choral conductors in India. Dr. Luethi received his DMA from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, his MM from the University of South Florida in Tampa, and his BM from the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay.
