


new member joins editorial board of review



PHILIP L. SMITH, who joins the Editorial Board of Review with this issue, is presently an assistant professor of philosophy of education at The Ohio State University. Since receiving his Ph.D. in 1971 from the University of Michigan he has pursued a number of special interests in the areas of moral philosophy and philosophical psychology. He believes these subjects to be at the heart of educational theorizing and plans to continue writing on the problems they present. Professor Smith has recently renewed his long-standing interests in educational historiography and the history of ideas.
