

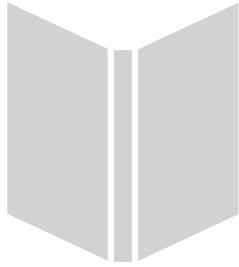

Chad Litz

Charles E. (Chad) Litz, the founding editor of *Educational Considerations*, passed away on December 17, 2014, at the age of 78. Chad nurtured and led the journal from its inception throughout much of its four decades of existence, serving as Chair of the Editorial Board until his retirement in 2004 as Professor of Educational History and Philosophy in the Department of Educational Leadership at Kansas State University. After his retirement, Chad continued to support the journal by following it faithfully and providing support and encouragement to its growth and influence. Chad loved a good and reasoned argument, the study of history, classical music, baseball (having played as a semi-professional), his bulldogs, a well-turned phrase, and *Educational Considerations*.
