THIRTEENTH NEW HAMPSHIRE SYMPOSIUM ON THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC

The 1987 Symposium will be held June 19-26, 1987 at the World Fellowship Center, Conway, NH. The central theme of the Symposium will be "Everyday Life in the GDR." As in past years the Symposium will be interdisciplinary. Several of the seminars will involve the treatment of topics from the perspectives of various disciplines.

Seminar topics will include: Quality of Life in the GDR (P. Herminhouse, Univ. of Rochester), The GDR and its International Environment (J. Parsons, Sloan School), Regional Differences in the GDR (M. Gerber), Arts and the (New) Media in the GDR (V. Gransow, U. of CA-Berkeley), Berlin: History, Culture, and Politics of a Modern Metropolis (D. Sweet, Bates College), New GDR Lyric Poetry (C. Cosentino, Rutgers), Issues and Trends in GDR Literature and Aesthetics (C.Z. Romero, Tufts Univ.), Methodology of the Study of GDR Literature, Culture, Society (M. Gerber).
