

On the Cover

This illustration is used as the cover illustration for "A Manual of Minor Vegetables." This book lists by common and scientific name, over 150 less known vegetables, describes how they are grown and cultivated, and tells about their use. Most are shown in photographs. The manual is a revenue producing item of the Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences, University of Florida.

Using photos as a reference, the illustration was rendered in ink using technical pens. The manual cover is printed with a second color over the vegetables as a light "wash." The vegetables shown are artichoke, asparagus, garlic, hyacinth bean, leek, mushroom, peanut and snap pea.


